SURFACE WATER TREATMENT PLANT

Ms. Miller updated the Board on the repair of raw water pump nos. 2 and 3 failed and the status of scheduling and completing all staff training related to raw water storage. The Board discussed the option to include an upgrade screen option for the raw water pumps and requested authorization for the additional expenditure to be paid for by the District.

Following review and discussion, Director Boyd moved to authorize the additional expenditure in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the upgrade to the raw water pump screening. The motion, which was seconded by Director Vance, passed unanimously.

The Board also discussed heating, ventilation, and air conditioning ("HVAC") issues noted by Director Vance upon inspection. Ms. Miller agreed to discuss the issues related to the HVAC system with LEM and Arcadis.
